

FIVE STATE CONVENTION GOLF SCRAMBLE

Thursday, September 27, 2018 – 18 Hole Scramble Format and Rules

Teams – 4 and 3 member teams:

Scramble Teams will consist of 4 players with no more than one player who is deemed an “A” player. If there are teams which consist of only 3 members, each team member will take turns hitting two balls per hole. The order shall be determined by the position they are listed on the scorecard.....this order should be maintained throughout the round.

Format:

On every hole each member of the team shall hit a tee shot. The team then selects one of the tee shots from which to play. All members of the team shall then hit from that position. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed. **Two tee shots from each golfer must be used during the 18 holes and marked on the score card when shots were used. Penalty for breach of this rule: two strokes for each tee shot not used.**

Ball Placement:

Each team member may place his/her ball within one club-length of the selected shot but no nearer the hole. If the shot selected is played from a hazard or the rough, it must remain in the hazard or rough no nearer the hole. On the putting surface, a team member may place his ball within one putter head length from the ball mark, no closer to the hole. Once the ball is holed, no further strokes count.

Mulligans - \$5 each or \$40 per team:

Players may purchase and use up to two mulligans. If a player uses a mulligan, he cannot use his first shot and must use the mulligan shot.

Skins - \$20 per team:

Skin is the low score starting with the hardest handicap hole on the course. If there is a tie for low score on the #1 handicap hole no skin will be given on that hole and we'll move to the 2nd hardest handicap hole and so forth until the tie is broken.

Tees:

Men will play from the White Tees and Ladies will play from the Red Tees.

Handicap/Scoring/Tie Breaker:

Handicaps for each team will be calculated at a percentage of the total team handicap (see bottom of team sheet for example). The team score will be determined by subtracting the team handicap from the gross score. (If a player does not have a handicap, please include the player's average score for 18 holes. – The committee will calculate a respective handicap to use for this event).

In the case of a tie, a playoff will be conducted by matching scorecards, starting at the hardest handicapped hole, then the next hardest handicapped hole and continuing until there is a winner.

Hole Prizes (holes will be announced at the Course):

Shortest Drive in fairway	Men
Longest Drive	Men
Longest Drive	Women
Closest to the Pin	Men
Closest to the Pin	Women
Longest Putt	Anyone
Closest to the Pin on 3 rd Shot (Par 5)	Anyone
Hole-In-One or Eagle Putt (Any Hole)	Anyone (Person making a Hole-In-One wins pin prize but buys beverages for everyone else, that's pretty standard in the rules of golf, right? Just mark it on score card what hole it was and who made it.)

GOLF CALCUTTA

Golf Teams will be auctioned off to the highest bidder/bidders. The receipts for each team will be divided with **20% going to the support of Five State Convention; 80% being used as prize money** for the top four teams: Prize money will be awarded with 40% going to 1st place team, 30% to 2nd place, 20% to 3rd place and 10% to the 4th place team. *Please note participation in the Golf Calcutta is optional.*
